Materials/instruments

2 steel string acoustic guitars (preferably large 'dreadnaught' style instruments

- If guitars lack internal microphones, piezo contact microphones should be attached to 2 line diagram above the stave indicate tremolo speed when no rhythmic notation is preset. the main body of the guitar, below the bridge

2 bows

Table(s)

Towels, pillows or other appropriate items to place the guitars on

Audio mixer/interface

2 speakers

Appropriate cables

The guitars should be placed on their back on tables, being played in this position throughout the piece. The amplification should be panned appropriately for the positions of the guitars, though not completely hard L/R

Place a pillow, towel or similar item between the guitar and the table to prevent audible bumps and sounds from the guitar moving around.

If the room doesn't allow for both guitars to be placed next to each other, or the performers only have access to one smaller table, placing both guitars on the same table with the performers facing each other is acceptable (see image below)

Should either be performed in an extremely 'reverberant' environment or have a heavy hallstyle reverb applied to the sounds.








